

Dagan Wells has been involved in preimplantation genetic diagnosis (PGD) and research into human gametes and embryos for over two decades. After studying at University College London, he relocated to the USA, working with Reprogenetics, one of the world's largest providers of PGD. Dagan established a research laboratory at Yale University, before returning to the UK. He is now an Associate Professor at the University of Oxford. Dagan's work has led to the publication of more than 150 papers, patents and multiple research grants and prizes. He serves on the Editorial Board of several journals and also directs Reprogenetics-UK, an independent laboratory offering state-of-the-art PGD services to IVF clinics throughout the UK and internationally.
